RCIA and Adult Confirmation—RCIA or “Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults” is the process of study and personal conversion where an unbaptized adult prepares to enter into the sacramental life of the Church. In their period of preparation these individuals are called “catechumens”. The Church also provides a process of preparation for individuals who have been baptized and who are seeking to receive First Holy Communion and/or Confirmation as adults. The Church refers to these individuals as “candidates”. If you would like to become either a catechumen or candidate for completing the three Sacraments of Initiation please contact Fr. Greg.
